- 3 There is no separate reportable segment as per Ind AS 108 on 'Operating Segments' for the Company since the Company primarily engaged in the business of financing.
- 4 During the quarter ended December 31, 2022 the Company allotted 81,08,108 equity shares to M/s. TVS Motor Company Limited by way of preferential issue.
- 5 In terms of the requirement as per RBI notification no. RBI/2019-20/170 DOR (NBFC). CC.PD.No.109/22.10.106/2019-20 dated 13th March 2020 on Implementation of Indian Accounting Standards, Non- Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs) are required to create an impairment reserve for any shortfall in impairment allowances under Ind AS 109 and Income Recognition, Asset Classification and Provisioning (IRACP) norms (including provision on standard assets). The impairment allowances under Ind AS 109 made by the Company exceeds the total provision required under IRACP (including standard asset provisioning), as at December 31, 2022 and accordingly, no amount is required to be transferred to impairment reserve.
- 6 The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) vide its circular no. RBI/2021-2022/125 DOR.STR.REC.68/21.04.048/2021-22, dated November 12, 2021 on "Prudential norms on Income Recognition, Asset Classification and Provisioning (IRACP) pertaining to Advances - Clarifications", had clarified / harmonized certain aspects of extant regulatory guidelines with a view to ensuring uniformity in the implementation of IRACP norms across all lending institutions. The Company has implemented the provisions of this circular under IRACP norms for regulatory purpose w.e.f. October 01, 2022, as clarified vide RBI circular no. The aforementioned circulars have no impact on the financial results for the nine month ended December 31, 2022, as the Company continues to prepare financial statements in accordance with Indian Accounting Standards ('Ind AS') notified under the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards, 2015 as amended and the RBI circular dated March 13, 2020 on "Implementation of Indian Accounting Standards.
- 7 Pursuant to SEBI Circular no. SEBI/HO/DDHS/DDHS/CIR/P/2019/115 dated 22 October 2019, all Commercial Paper issued on or after 01 January, 2020 have been listed on the National Stock Exchange (NSE).
- 8 As on December 31, 2022 the security cover available in respect of secured non convertible debt securities is 1.15. 2 The above financial results of the Group have been prepared in accordance with Indian Accounting Standards ('Ind AS') notified under the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 as amended by the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2016, prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act 2013 ('the Act') read with relevant rules issued thereunder and the other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Besides, the Company follows application guidance, clarifications, circulars and directions issued by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) for Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFC) or other regulators, as and when they are issued and applicable.

3 The above financial results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and subsequently approved by the Board of Directors of the Company at their meetings held on January 23, 2022 and subjected to limited review by joint statutory auditors, pursuant to Regulation 52 of the Securities Exchange Board of India ("SEBI") (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended and Paragraph 7 of Operational Circular SEBI/HO/DDHS/P/CIR/2021/613 "Continuous disclosure requirements for listed Commercial Paper" dated 10th August 2021, as amended.

4 There is no separate reportable segment as per Ind AS 108 on 'Operating Segments' for the Company since the Company primarily engaged in the business of financing.

- 5 In terms of the requirement as per RBI notification no. RBI/2019-20/170 DOR (NBFC). CC.PD.No.109/22.10.106/2019-20 dated 13th March 2020 on Implementation of Indian Accounting Standards, Non- Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs) are required to create an impairment reserve for any shortfall in impairment allowances under Ind AS 109 and Income Recognition, Asset Classification and Provisioning (IRACP) norms (including provision on standard assets). The impairment allowances under Ind AS 109 made by the Company exceeds the total provision required under IRACP (including standard asset provisioning), as at December 31, 2022 and accordingly, no amount is required to be transferred to impairment reserve.
- 6 The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) vide its circular no. RBI/2021-2022/125 DOR.STR.REC.68/21.04.048/2021-22, dated November 12, 2021 on "Prudential norms on Income Recognition, Asset Classification and Provisioning (IRACP) pertaining to Advances Clarifications", had clarified / harmonized certain aspects of extant regulatory guidelines with a view to ensuring uniformity in the implementation of IRACP norms across all lending institutions. The Company has implemented the provisions of this circular under IRACP norms for regulatory purpose w.e.f. October 01, 2022, as clarified vide RBI circular on RBI/2021-2022/158 DOR.STR.REC.85/21.04.048/2021-22 dated February 15, 2022. The aforementioned circulars have no impact on the financial results for the quarter ended December 31, 2022, as the Company continues to prepare financial statements in accordance with Indian Accounting Standards ('Ind AS') notified under the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 as amended and the RBI circular dated March 13, 2020 on "Implementation of Indian Accounting Standards.
- 7 Pursuant to SEBI Circular no. SEBI/HO/DDHS/DDHS/CIR/P/2019/115 dated 22 October 2019, all Commercial Paper issued on or after 01 January, 2020 have been listed on the National Stock Exchange (NSE).
- 8 The figures for the quarter ended December 31, 2022 and December 31, 2021 are the balancing figures between reviewed figures in respect of the nine months ended December 31, 2022 and December 31, 2021 and the reviewed figures for the half year ended September 30, 2022 and September 30, 2021 respectively.
